- What products we make in our country




**In ICT the children will learn:**

- What is being done to help the least developed countries





**In Music the children will be:**

- Learning and rehearsing songs with inspiring music
- Learning about pitch, tone and volume
- Learning how to sing songs in a round




**In French the children will be focussing on:**

- How to respond to simple questions about age, family members and feelings
- How to put what we have learned into conversations

**In Technology the children will learn:**

- How people, food and water are transported
- How wheels, levers, pulleys, slides and floats work



**In Maths the children will be:**

- Learning to count in multiples of 4, 8, 50 and 100
- Learning to find 10 or 100 more or less than a given number
- Learning to read and write numbers up to 1000 in numerals and words
- Learning to recognise the place value of each digit in a three digit number (hundreds, tens, ones)
- Learning to count up and down in tenths
- Reviewing their work on telling and writing the time from an analogue clock
- Learning how many seconds are in a minute and the number of days in each month, year and leap year



**In English the children will be:**

- Looking at stories from other cultures
- Learning how to use a and an correctly
- Learning to create nouns by adding prefixes
- Writing stories where pronouns will be used to avoid repetition in their sentences
- Reviewing their work on how to correctly use inverted commas in speech and conjunctions to add more details and information to their sentences



**In RE the children will be focussing on:**

- How to tell the difference between right and wrong
- How different religions help us to understand what is right and wrong
- Why people are inspired by different religious leaders
