

Year 6—Being Human Spring 2

In Technology the children will be learning:

- How to plan and prepare a healthy meal
- To gather and use information to suggest solutions to problems
- To devise and use step-by-step plans
- To work with a variety of tools and materials with some accuracy

In PSHE the children will be:

- Learning how the media can have positive and negative impacts on our views
- Sharing personal goals and set further goals for the future
- Learning to explain and discuss tricky situations and how best to deal with them

In RE the children will be learning to:

- Understand the difference between theist, agnostic and atheist and how our individual beliefs may change the way we live
- Discuss their feelings towards their individual beliefs
- Listen to and discuss other people's view towards God

In PE the children will learn:

- How to hit a ball into a space to increase a score
- How to help other members of a team to find space
- How to choose the most appropriate throw to use in a game

In Science the children will be finding out:

- How humans are different from other animals
- About the brain and nervous system
- About the bones and muscles in the body
- How the human heart works
- How we breathe and what the lungs do
- What we inherit from our parents
- How our environment affects us
- How the body uses food and water
- About the latest medical research
- How to conduct scientific investigations posing scientific questions
- How to choose an appropriate way to investigate a scientific issue
- How to make systematic and accurate measurements from their observations
- How to explain and justify their predictions, investigations, findings and conclusions
- How to record and communicate their findings accurately using the most appropriate medium and the appropriate scientific vocabulary and conventions

In French the children will be:

- Learning to name places and activities that can be completed in a local town

In ICT the children will be focussing on:

- Creating scripts, making and editing films about the school

In Maths the children will be:

- Recapping on formal written methods for addition, subtraction, division and multiplications
- Learning to use scale factors to solve everyday problems
- Learning to tell time to the nearest minute and use this to solve problems
- Learning to translate and reflect shapes through and across axis

In English the children will be:

- Continuing to learn how to spell a range of spelling patterns
- Learning how to use semi colons, commas and dashes to mark boundaries between clauses
- Learning how to hyphenate words
- Learning how to build cohesion across paragraphs

In Music the children will be:

- Looking at how pitch, tone and volume in voices can portray emotion or mood
- Learning how to sing harmonies

In International the children will be finding out:

- About a major global health problem
- If we can improve the health of the world's children
- How the lives of people in one country are affected by the activities of other countries or groups
- How to identify ways in which people work together for mutual benefit
